












MILANKA BROOKS MAKES HER EDINBURGH FRINGE DEBUT

The show will be at Assembly George Square, The Crate from 31st July - 25th August. Tickets are on sale now.

Mum and I Don't Talk Anymore is the eagerly awaited writing debut from actress Milanka Brooks - a show about her relationship with her Serbian mother...and perhaps most importantly, an introduction to Slivovitz. But at the heart of it is two women who'd discuss everything from perfecting their exercise routine, to libertine lovers, to scissoring. But the big question is, why do Milanka and her Mum not talk anymore?

This is an extremely funny, candid and poignant debut solo show about the unique and crazy relationship between Milanka and her flamboyant mother, Lela. A touching story of a female double act who together hustled their way through life's challenges. Through a series of incredible characters introduced throughout, audiences truly get to know Lela and are invited on a journey that will leave you feeling inspired and ready to take on the world, "Dat is inevitable". as she would sav.

On making her Edinburgh debut Milanka said: "I'm so thrilled to be bringing my first solo show to this year's Fringe Festival. For years I've been hoping to make a piece about my mother and the eccentricities of our relationship. As I created the piece, Edinburgh was always the ultimate goal as The Fringe is undoubtedly the home of the one-person show. I've ensured that as the audience meets Mum, and experiences our, sometimes wild stories, that they'll also encounter a few other people along with much humour and heart, and I'm excited to take the audience on a journey that I hope



will not only entertain, but also bring plenty of passion, poignancy, and promise."






